# Project “DRUSHTI”

The Drushti Project is dedicated to delivering vital eye care services to underprivileged communities, focusing on awareness, early detection, and treatment of vision-related issues. The main goals of the eye camp were as follows:

- To offer free eye examinations for the early identification of vision problems.
- To distribute spectacles and provide necessary medical support.
- To promote awareness about eye health and hygiene practices.
- To facilitate referrals for cataract surgeries and additional treatment as needed.

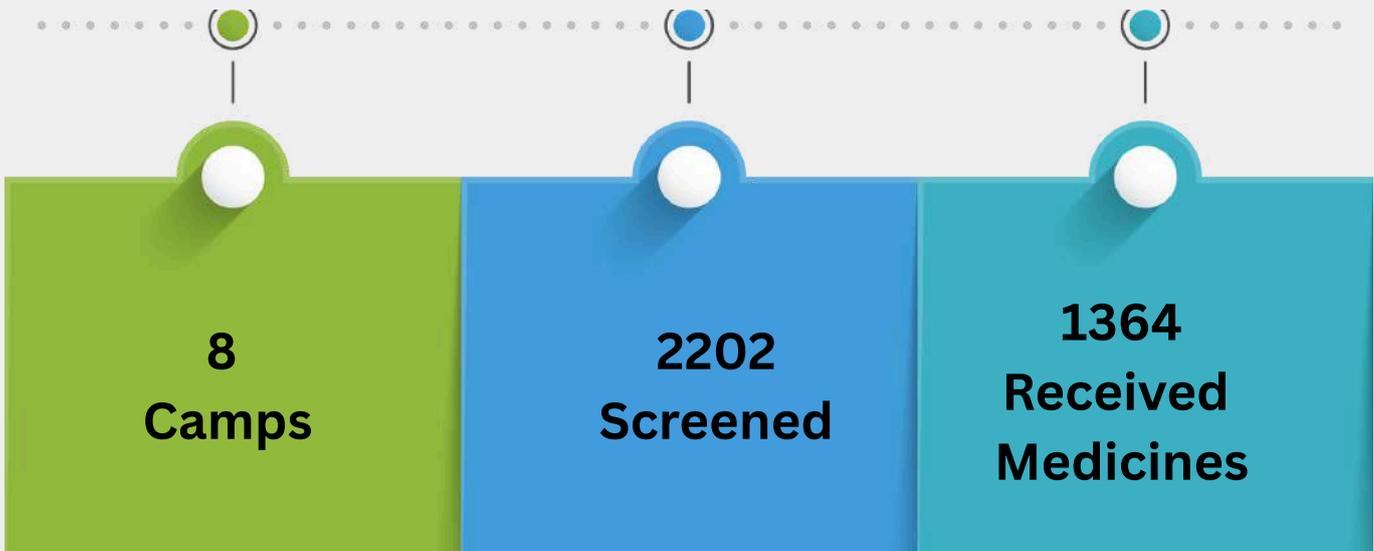

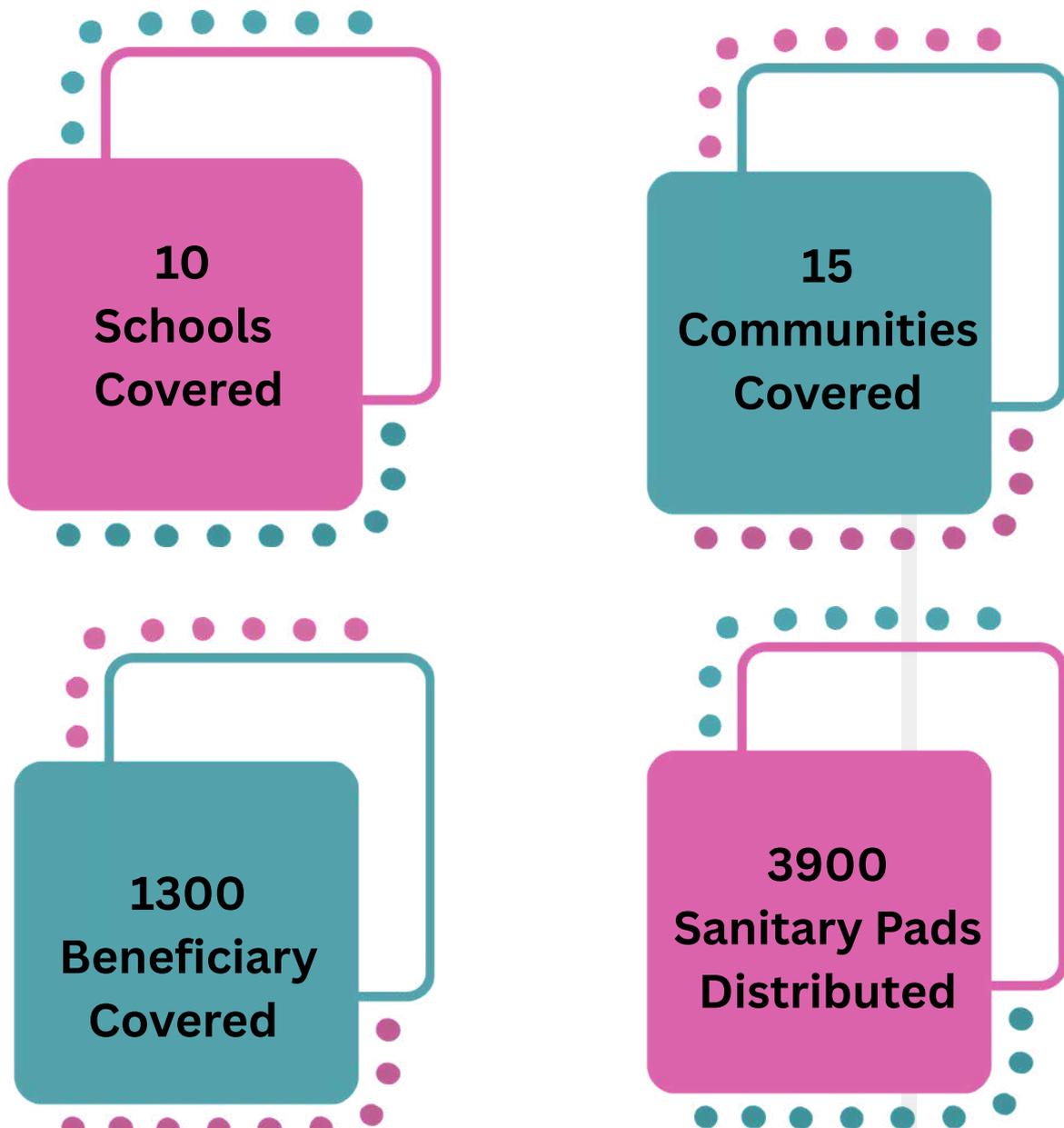


# Project “SABLA”

It works toward reintegrating children into mainstream education and society, while also providing after-care support to help them lead independent, dignified lives.

## “Gram and Pragati Mitra”

SAAD Foundation’s Gram Mitra and Pragati Mitra Project focuses on empowering underprivileged rural and urban slum communities through grassroots engagement and awareness. Under this initiative, Gram Mitras work in rural areas and Pragati Mitras operate in urban slums to create awareness about key themes such as food security, livelihood, and social entitlements. They act as bridges between the community and government schemes, helping people access their rights and benefits. Through campaigns, home visits, stakeholder meetings, and documentation support, these Mitras play a vital role in building safer, healthier, and more informed communities.

Later, when she faced serious ear and nose issues, doctors advised surgery. Thanks to the Ayushman card, her operation—costing around ₹50,000—was done free of charge.
